INTRODUCTION



A Contractor to CRL was recently working within a very restricted and congested work area. To make some space they decided to park one of the forklifts outside of the planned work area on a pedestrian pathway.

Below the pathway was a large service void. The forklift's back wheel overloaded and damaged the service void cover.

REASON FOR ISSUING THIS ALERT

To remind people of the need to thoroughly examine the work area to identify such service ducts and voids and to remain within the planned work areas.

CONCLUSIONS AND DISCUSSION POINTS

Fortunately, there were no injuries. Changes to the planned work often increases the risk of injury or property damage.
