INTRODUCTION

As is common practice, a hydrodemolition contractor's employee was drying PPE in the back of their vehicle when a discarded glove came in contact with a hot pump motor. The motor did have a protective cage designed to keep flammable materials safe by distance, however this did not prevent the glove from coming in contact with the hot surface. The PPE started to smoulder and developed into a small fire that was quickly tackled with a fire extinguisher.



It is important that we provide suitable and sufficient facilities for storing and drying clothing and PPE.

This event reminds us of the risk of fire when drying clothing and PPE adjacent to heat producing appliances.

To inform people of the risks posed when drying clothing and PPE

Ensure that clothing and PPE is not dried on or too close to hot surfaces
