A recent incident occurred when employees attempted to move an aluminium mobile tower without reducing its height. The tower toppled over. Fortunately no one was injured.

When using mobile towers, supervisors and users must refer to the manufacturer's instructions which will give information in relation to moving the tower (see example below).

Manufacturer's instructions must be provided by the hire company.

Moving the Tower

Before moving the tower, its overall height should be reduced to 4m working platform height or less. No persons, tools, equipment or materials shall be permitted to remain on the tower when it is being moved.
